


## PRICE DEVELOPMENTS REPORT APRIL 2024

This report is prepared on a monthly basis using monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) data from the Samoa Bureau of Statistics.



The Headline Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of April edged up by 0.4 percent over the previous month due to hikes in both its local and imported components, by 0.6 percent and 0.3 percent respectively. Additionally, the headline CPI was also 1.9 percent higher compared to the same month of last year.



Despite the slight improvement in the month under review, the **annual average inflation** rate slid further down to 5.1 percent from 5.9 percent in the previous month and well below 11.7 percent in April 2023. This reflected reductions in both the local inflation (down to 5.9 percent from 6.9 percent) and imported inflation (down to 4.4 percent from 5.1 percent) over the previous month.



The overall increase in the CPI in April 2024 mirrored increases in the following sub-groups:


- 'Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages' rose by 0.3 percent mirroring higher prices for imported goods such as sugar, tinned fish, apples, rice to name a few, despite a drop in its local component.
- 'Transport' (up by 1.2 percent) reflecting a gain of 2.4 percent in its imported component (due to higher prices for petrol and diesel) whereas its local component fell by 0.1 percent (lower price for Apia-Auckland return trip airfares).
- 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels' (up by 0.3 percent) due to higher prices for imported goods such as kerosene and timber.
- 'Miscellaneous goods and services' (up by 0.5 percent) reflecting higher prices for imported toiletries products such as soap and diapers.
- 'Furnishings, Household equipment, and Maintenance' (up by 1.9 percent) highlighting increase in its imported component (mainly washing soap, washing powder and futon mattress).
- 'Clothing and Footwear' recorded a gain of 0.2 percent reflecting higher prices for nike running shoes.
- 'Recreation and Culture' (rose by 2.6 percent) reflecting higher price of a laptop.

In contrast, the following sub-groups recorded reductions in the month under review:

• 'Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco' (dropped by 0.1 percent) due to a contraction in its local component, reflecting lower prices for taula beer whereas the imported component (edged up by 0.1 percent).

The 'Communication' 'Restaurants' 'Education' and 'Health' sub-groups remained steady for the month under review.

The underlying CPI¹ dropped further by 0.1 percent over the previous month and was 3.8 percent higher when compared to the same month of last year. As a result, the annual average underlying inflation rate fell to 7.0 percent from 7.9 percent in the previous month and 13.4 percent in April of 2023.
