

PRICE DEVELOPMENTS REPORT DECEMBER 2021

This report is prepared on a monthly basis using monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) data from the Samoa Bureau of Statistics.

Report No.6: 2021/22

December 2021

The monthly **Headline Consumer Price Index** (CPI) rebounded by 2.1 percent over the previous month due to a sharp hike in its imported component by 3.9 percent while its local component remained at the same level. In addition, it was 11.6 percent higher than in the same month last year.

As a result, the **annual average headline inflation rate** rose further to 3.1 percent from 1.8 percent in the previous month and was -1.6 percent in December 2020. Mainly accounting for this overall increase over the month were expansions in its imported component (to 5.7 percent from 3.4 percent) and local component (to 0.6 percent from 0.2 percent).

In terms of individual subgroups, the 'Transport' sub-index rose by 5.0 percent due to a 7.8 percent increase in its imported component (mostly higher prices for petrol and diesel). The "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" sub-index also jumped by 2.5 percent due to increases in both its imported component (up 3.5 percent for items such as onions, turkey wings and rice), and its local component (up by 0.1 percent mainly reflecting increased prices for taamu, tomatoes, fish and coconuts to name a few).

Similarly, the "Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels" sub-index also increased by 1.8 percent due to a 6.6 percent gain in its imported component (mainly cement, kerosene, paint and timber). Moreover, "Furnishing, household equipment and maintenance", "Miscellaneous goods and services" and "Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco" sub-indices all reported increases of 1.0 percent, 0.2 percent and 0.1 percent in that order.

All the other sub-groups including "Communication", "Clothing and Footwear", "Education", "Health", Recreation and Culture" and "Restaurants" remained the same for the month under review.

Likewise, the **underlying CPI**¹ recorded an increase of 2.0 percent over the month but was 11.7 percent higher than its level in the same month last year. As a result, the **annual average underlying inflation rate** went up further to 3.2 percent from 1.9 percent in the previous month and even higher than -0.5 percent in December 2020.
