

PRICE DEVELOPMENTS REPORT NOVEMBER 2021

This report is prepared on a monthly basis using monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) data from the Samoa Bureau of Statistics.

Report No.5: 2021/22

November 2021

Following an increase in the previous month, the **Headline Consumer Price Index (CPI)** fell by 0.5 percent over October 2021 but was 9.5 percent higher when compared to November 2020. Responsible for this reduction over the month were decreases in both its local and imported components which were down by 0.9 percent and 0.1 percent in that order.

The annual average headline inflation rate continued to accelerate rising to 1.8 percent in November 2021 from 0.5 percent in the previous month and -0.9 percent in November 2020. At this level, the headline inflation rate grew much faster than expected at 0.9 percent. This was due to higher than expected increases in both imported inflation and local inflation.

By individual subgroups, the "Food and Non – Alcoholic" sub-index edged up by 1.7 percent due to a 7.9 percent hike in its local component (mostly higher prices for taro, ta'amu and banana). The "Transport" and "Restaurants" sub-indices both increased by 0.3 percent over the month. The increase in the former reflected a 1.5 percent improvement in its imported component (higher prices for diesel and petrol) while that of the latter reflected a 0.3 percent hike in its local component.

Similarly, the "Clothing and Footwear" subgroup also went up by 0.1 percent due to a 0.2 percent increase in its imported component (mostly higher prices for ie solosolo).

In contrast, the "Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels" sub-index fell by 12.0 percent over the month. This decrease mirrored a 16.5 percent drop in its local inflation, which was mainly driven by lower prices for cash power and water, in light of a 20 percent reduction in utility rates as per Government Budget

2021/22. In addition, the "Furnishings household equipment and maintenance" subgroup also recorded a reduction of 0.2 percent due to a similar drop in its imported component.

The "Alcoholic beverage and tobacco", "Health", "Communication", "Recreation and Culture", "Education" and "Miscellaneous goods and services" sub-indices all remained the same in November 2021.

The monthly **underlying CPI**¹ declined by 0.3 percent over the month but was 9.8 percent higher than that of November 2020. Nevertheless, the **annual average underlying CPI** hiked up further to 1.9 percent from 0.6 percent in the last month and 0.3 percent in the same month last year.
