## VISITOR EARNINGS & REMITTANCES REPORT JANUARY 2017

This report is a monthly release of the latest available indicators on the tourism sector and private remittances, with information sourced from the Central Bank, Samoa Bureau of Statistics and the Ministry for Revenue.

Report No.7: 2016/17 January 2017

Post festive season, the total **visitor arrivals** returned to normal levels, down by 36.2 percent to a seasonal level of 11,907. This was also 1.6 percent lower when compared to the same month last year. At this level, it was below its average increases of 7.6 percent and 4.7 percent in the past 3 years and 5 years respectively.

**Total arrivals in the first seven months of 2016/17** were 0.8 percent lower than the same period in 2015/16 reflecting the recent slowdown in holiday tourists and those visiting friends and relatives.

By country, visitors from American Samoa, Australia, New Zealand, USA and Europe all recorded seasonal decreases of 55.7 percent, 43.2 percent, 34.3 percent, 24.5 percent and 8.0 percent respectively. For arrivals by purpose, genuine holidaymakers, 'visiting friends and relatives' and 'business & conference' all recorded reductions of 48.4 percent, 38.6 percent and 11.6 percent respectively.

Despite a 7.6 percent expansion in the **overall average expenditure per visitor**, **total visitor receipts** fell moderately by 31.4 percent (\$14.6 million) from the previous month and was 5.2 percent (\$1.8 million) lower compared to January 2016.

**Total visitor receipts in the first seven months of 2016/17** were 1.2 percent lower compared to the same period in 2015/16. This current level was in contrast with its average gains of 9.6 percent and 7.6 percent for the past 3 and 5 years respectively.

After the seasonal high in the previous month, **total private remittances** shrank by 29.6 percent (\$12.9

million) to \$30.7 million. Nevertheless, it was 14.5 percent higher than January 2016.

Consequently, total inflow of private remittances in the first seven months of 2016/17 was 4.1 percent higher compared to the same period 2016. This was higher than its average decrease of 2.0 percent in the past 3 years and its 1.8 percent average increase in the past 5 years.

Primarily underpinning the overall decline in private remittances were reductions in remittances inflows from American Samoa, Australia, New Zealand and the United States of America, which fell by 24.5 percent, 32.6 percent, 32.8 percent and 26.5 percent in that order. Moreover, analysis by recipients showed that the overall drop was due to decreases in transfers for 'households and individuals' and 'hand-carried cash'.

The share of private remittances received through money transfer operators (MTOs) fell to 86.2 percent from 91.8 percent in the previous month, whilst remittances coming through the banking system improved to 13.8 percent.

The **cost of sending** NZD \$200.00 to Samoa averaged around 12.8 percent, down from 13.6 percent in December 2016. In terms of cheapest transfer service from New Zealand, it was again KlickEx – Low priority. The **cost of sending** AUD \$200.00 to Samoa averaged at 12.2 percent and the cheapest money transfer operator was Compass Global Markets.
