

PRICE DEVELOPMENTS REPORT AUGUST 2019

This report is prepared on a monthly basis using monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) data from the Samoa Bureau of Statistics.

Report No.2: 2019/20

August 2019

The Headline Consumer Prices Index (CPI) dropped by 0.1 percent over the month as the reduction in its imported component of 0.5 percent more than offset an increase in the local component of 0.4 percent. However, the overall CPI was 0.6 percent higher when compared to August 2018.

The *annual average headline inflation rate* edged down to 1.3 percent from 1.7 percent a month ago and was well below a 4.4 percent in August 2018. This current performance of annual inflation was accounted for by both reductions in the local component to 3.4 percent from 3.5 percent and the imported component to -0.6 percent from -0.02 percent in the previous month.

By individual subgroups, the "Transport" subindex fell moderately by 3.5 percent. This accounted for a drop of 3.5 percent in its imported component (mainly petrol and diesel prices) offsetting a 0.8 percent gain in local component. In addition, both the "Furnishing, Household equipment and Maintenance" and "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels" (mainly kerosene) sub-indexes each declined by 0.4 percent.

On the other hand, the "Food and Non Alcoholic Beverages" subgroup increased by 1.1 percent as a result of higher prices of its imported component by 1.3 percent (mainly the prices of chicken leg quarter and butter) and its local component by 0.9 percent (mainly higher prices for fish, banana and coconuts). Similarly, the "Miscellaneous goods and services" subgroup increased by 0.5 percent.

At the Local Produce Markets, the overall volume of agricultural produce supplies (main source of local food) fell by 3.2 percent which pushed the Market overall price index up by 6.4 percent.

However, "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics", "Clothing and Footwear", "Health", "Communication", "Recreation and Culture", "Education" and "Restaurant" were all unchanged in the month under review.

The underlying CPI¹ registered a 0.6 percent increase stemming from an increase in its imported component by 0.9 percent while local component was unchanged from the preceding month. On the other hand, the annual average underlying CPI edged down to -0.6 from -0.3 percent in the previous month and was well below 3.9 percent in August 2018.

¹ Underlying CPI takes into account the effects of both external and local pressure on prices for commodities that are not subject to extreme volatility and price regulations.
