

PRICE DEVELOPMENTS REPORT OCTOBER 2020

This report is prepared on a monthly basis using monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) data from the Samoa Bureau of Statistics.

Report No.4: 2020/21

The **Headline Consumer Price Index (CPI)** declined by 1.9 percent from the previous month and was 5.8 percent lower when compared to October 2019. The current reduction was underpinned by decreases of 3.5 percent in its imported component and 0.3 percent in its local component from the preceding month.

Nevertheless, the *annual average headline inflation rate* fell further to -0.2 percent (deflation) from 0.4 percent in September 2020 and 0.8 percent in October 2019. This has reflected further slowdowns in both imported inflation, to -0.9 percent from -0.1 percent and local inflation to 0.5 percent from 0.8 percent.

By individual subgroups, the *"Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages"* sub-index has dropped further by 4.8 percent during the month. This was due to reductions in both its imported component, by 6.6 percent (reflecting lower prices for chicken leg quarter, sugar, turkey wings and rice to name a few) and its local component by 1.1 percent (lower prices for stable crops and vegetable items like round cabbage and tomatoes).

Furthermore, the *"Recreation and Culture"* subgroup registered a drop of 0.6 percent following a decrease of 0.7 percent in its imported component (due to a lower price for a laptop).

Similarly, the "Miscellaneous goods & services", "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & other Fuels" and "Furnishings, Household Equipment & Maintenance" sub-indexes fell by 0.4 percent, 0.3 percent and 0.1 percent for the month.

On the other hand, the *"Transport"* sub-index registered a modest increase of 1.0 percent

October 2020 reflecting a 1.6 percent hike in its imported component (reflecting higher price for petrol) despite a steady trend in its local component.

The "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics", "Clothing & Footwear", "Communication", "Health", "Education" and "Restaurants" subindexes remained the same for the month.

The monthly **underlying CPI**¹ fell by 3.2 percent and was 6.1 percent lower compared to the same month last year. The **annual average underlying CPI** also slipped to 1.0 percent from 1.7 percent but was much higher than -0.6 percent in October 2019.

¹ Underlying CPI takes into account the effects of both external and local pressure on prices for commodities that are not subject to extreme volatility and price regulations.
