The ECOSOC Financing for Development Forum Follow Up is currently taking place from the 15-18 April 2019 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. It is an intergovernmental process that is mandated to review the Addis Ababa Action Agenda and other financing for development outcomes and the means of implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals. (SDGs). The forum is being attended by the Samoa delegation which is headed by the Governor of the Central Bank of Samoa, Maiava Atalina Emma Ainuu-Enari. She is also currently serving on the United Nations Secretary General's Digital Financing Taskforce for the Sustainable Development Goals where she brings in the Pacific perspective on the potential of financial technologies to achieve the SDGs. Maiava was part of the panel for the Ministerial Finance Dialogue that looked at the topic 'Harnessing New Technologies for Financing the SDGs' whereby she provided national context in regards to connectivity and digitization in Samoa.
